
Chairman's Message - Ann Southall (con't.)

Meet Grant Recipient Oghogho Igodan

Born in Nigeria and raised in South Africa, Oghogho is a public health professional passionate about maternal, newborn and child health, sexual and reproductive health, family planning and health equity. She earned a Master of Public Health in



Maternal and Child Health from George Washington University and Bachelor of Arts in Internal Studies with minors in French and Women's Studies from Ohio State University. She currently works as a Humanitarian Advisor at the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), where she manages projects focused on strengthening the capacity of humanitarian leaders and local and national NGOs.

Oghogho is passionate about giving back and has volunteered with several organizations focused on maternal and child health, health equity, adolescent health, and child marriage. Oghogho serves as a board member of Dr. Shalon's Maternal Action Project and has volunteered with UNICEF. Too Young to Wed, Mary's Center for Maternal and Child Care, and the African Cultural and Resource Center. She is the recipient of the 2018 Association of Maternal & Child Health Programs Go Beyond Maternal and Child Health Graduate Student Scholarship and is a 2022 Johnson & Jonson One Young World Scholar.

Oghogho is extremely grateful to the ESA Foundation for awarding her the Career Enhancement Grant. The grant enabled her to participate in a postpartum doula training with Nurturing Doula Dreams and covered DONA International membership and postpartum doula certification processing fees.

Oghogho said the ESAF Career Enhancement Grant is an investment in her long-term goals. In the future, Oghogho's long term career goal is to work as a Senior Maternal Health Advisor at a U.S. federal government agency or private foundation and to have her own doula business.
